






#### Estonian municipalities, 2024









Estonian municipalities, 2045








## Age composition in large cities and rural Estonia, 2023






Changing role of urban housing


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Highlights

### Migration Concentration Index MCI




### Migration Concentration Index in Estonia




### Migration Concentration Index of families
